



Manulife Centre Redevelopment Update

August, 2017

The \$100 million redevelopment at Manulife Centre will add 35,000 square feet of new retail space. The redevelopment will include a complete overhaul of the exterior of the Centre, as well as a reconfiguration of the interior space. During construction, some of your usual pathways and entrances to the building may also be rerouted.

We will make it a priority to communicate with all our tenants during construction to minimize disruption. Enclosed is a detailed list of construction milestones taking place over the next couple of weeks. Please note: dates and activities are subject to change without notice.

Important Information:

- Construction in the parking garage has begun, directional signage will be in place for any parking rerouting.
- A temporary entrance to Manulife Centre will open on the east side of Bloor street on August 15th. The current temporary entrance will be closed when the east side entrance opens.
- Demolition of the Bloor Street atrium has begun, noise will be loud at times.
- Parking is no longer available on Balmuto street, bike racks have been relocated to Bay street.
