



# Manulife Centre Redevelopment Update

September 2017

Enclosed is this month's update of construction milestones taking place over the next couple of weeks. Please note: dates and activities are subject to change without notice. During construction, some of your usual pathways and entrances to the building may also be rerouted. We will make it a priority to communicate with all our tenants during construction to minimize disruption.

## **Important Information:**

- There are two temporary entrances to the centre located on the West and East side of Bloor Street. Expect entrances to alternate, observe on site signage to direct you to open entrances.
- Construction in the parking garage has begun, directional signage will be in place for any parking rerouting.
- Demolition of the Bloor Street atrium is underway, noise will be loud at times.
- Parking is no longer available on Balmuto Street, bike racks have been relocated to Bay Street.

The \$100 million redevelopment at Manulife Centre will add 35,000 square feet of new retail space. The redevelopment will include a complete overhaul of the exterior of the Centre, as well as a reconfiguration of the interior space.
