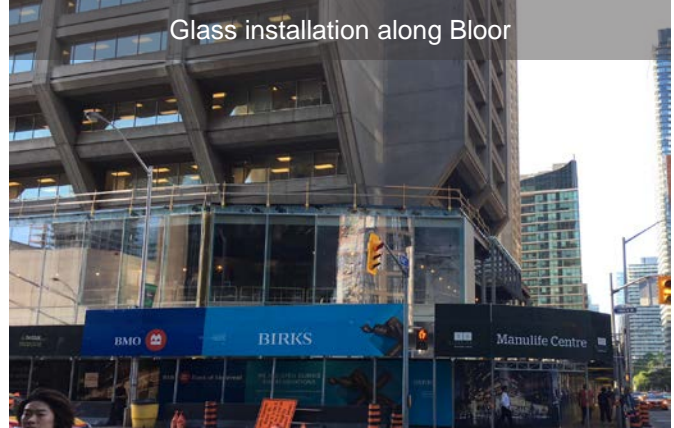




Manulife Centre Redevelopment Update

Hello Manulife Centre Tenants! We hope you all had a wonderful Canada Day with friends and family. The Manulife Centre Redevelopment project continues to move forward with some exciting new milestones reached. Glass installation along Bloor Street is now complete and will be turning the corner onto Bay Street shortly. Demolition along Bay Street will be continuing with steel not far behind. New escalators have been delivered and are awaiting installation.

Enclosed is this month's update of construction milestones taking place over the next couple of months. Please note: dates and activities are subject to change without notice. During construction, some of your usual pathways and entrances to the building may also be rerouted. We will make it a priority to communicate with all our tenants during construction to minimize disruption.

Important Information:

- Roof installation along Bloor Street is in progress
- The curtain wall (glass) installation has been completed along Bloor Street. Installation on Bay Street to continue.
- Erection of steel continues on Balmuto & Bay.
- Slab removals continue along Bay and Balmuto Streets, noise will be loud.
- Complimentary valet parking services available to tenants.
