It's time to freshen up for fall! The Manulife Centre Redevelopment project continues to move forward with some exciting new milestones reached. Glass and steel installation continues along Bay and Balmuto Streets. Rexall and Stitch It have both relocated to the Holt Renfrew Centre to make way for construction. We would like to thank them for their years of providing excellent service to customers and wish them success in their new locations. We are pleased to announce that Shoppers Drug Mart will be opening in early 2019 on the concourse level beside Indigo. Enclosed is this month's update of construction milestones taking place over the next couple of months. Please note: dates and activities are subject to change without notice. During construction, some of your usual pathways and entrances to the building may also be rerouted. We will make it a priority to communicate with all our tenants during construction to minimize disruption.

Important Information:

- Roof installation along Bloor Street is completed.
- The curtain wall (glass) installation has switched from Bay Street to Balmuto Street, work is at night.
- Erection of steel continues on Balmuto & Bay.
- Slab removals continue along Bay Street, noise will be loud.
- Complimentary valet parking services available to tenants.
